Over the summer break, school staff have given much of their time to prepare their classrooms and to plan an exciting curriculum for the new year ahead. 'Magic Moments'

Year 1 We have built zero to ten number tracks with Numicon pieces and number cards., being marvellous mathematicians.

Year 2 We have explored habitats in the school grounds. They used magnifying glasses to make detailed drawings of their observations.

Year 3 We have come back to school with enthusiasm, eager to start their learning journey We have begun our History topic about WW2 and enjoyed getting outside to improve our overarm throwing. We have also started our new class stories, 'Charlotte's Web' and 'The Matchbox diaries'.

Year 4 This week, Year 4 have been learning lots of new vocabulary about the digestive system, including oesophagus, salivary glands, pancreas, intestines, rectum and anus. We attempted to label these body parts on an outline of one of our friends.

Year 5 We have been sharing our prior knowledge about The Victorians and discussing how they lived. We have also introduced our class reading texts; 'Rooftoppers' Katherine Rundell and 'Sky Chasers' Emma Carroll.

Year 6 We have spent time thinking about what it means to be in Year 6 and the values and attitudes expected of them. They compared this to DNA (what makes us individual and what makes us a class) and then created their own DNA bracelets showing the importance of each of the qualities to them.

Eco-Schools This week you will have received a letter informing you of how we are encouraging more families to either park and stride or walk to school. Children will self-report their daily journeys on the WOW Travel Tracker. At the end of each month, the children who have travelled sustainably to school at least once a week receive a WOW badge.

Welcome to the Brookhurst BIG Family. It has been a pleasure to welcome our new F2 children and their families as part of their induction to BIG school. We are all looking forward to Monday for their first day with us.
