Dear Families

Here we are at the end of another busy and enjoyable academic year. The children have given their very best and all deserve a restful summer break. I do hope you enjoyed reading about their progress and achievements in their end of year school report.

The Ofsted inspection in February 2024 validated our judgements that we are now a securely GOOD school. The curriculum is ambitious and fit for purpose and the quality of education has consistently improved. It is anticipated that school performance SATS results at the end of year 6, will greatly improve in summer 2025. This is due to the children having more time with the improved key stage 2 curriculum and higher expectations. As we are aware, we just do not judge a school on its effectiveness by year 6 SATS results. We celebrate that our current year 6 have all made personal progress from their starting points but they are just not close enough to national expectations – they needed more time with our much improved and ambitious connected curriculum. I am confident that they will continue to catch-up and be successful in their GCSE examinations.

Year 6 Leavers Celebration: Last Friday afternoon, year 6 performed their end of year 'Leavers Celebration' to their families. It was marvellous watching them share their memories of their time in school. The assembly finished with an emotional presentation from the F2 Buddies to their year 6 Buddies. We wish our year 6 all the very best for the next stage of their learning journey – you will be missed. This year the Governors' Award for contribution to school life, was presented to Anthony in year 6. Well done Anthony and thoroughly deserved.
